# **Unplanned Pregnancy**

- Almost half of pregnancies every year are either unplanned or unwanted. An unwanted pregnancy certainly places a woman in a predicament.

# Why Do People Have Abortion?

While every person has unique reasons for seeking an abortion, researchers have found that those who've had the procedure report a number of common factors that influenced their decision.

- Financial reasons
- Not a good time
- Issues with partner

- Need to focus on other children
- Interferes with future plans
- Unprepared emotionally or mentally
- Health issue
- Unable to provide a "good" life
- Lack maturity or self-sufficiency
- Influence from family or friends
- Don't want children
- Don't want to place baby for adoption



# **Best And Safest Way To Terminate The Early Pregnancy**

- <u>Purchase Abortion Pill online</u> where Mifepristone is administered orally on Day 1 in the form of a 200 mg pill. The hormone progesterone, which your body needs to develop a pregnancy, is blocked by this medicine.
- Misoprostol, which dissolves in your cheek or vagina, is taken on days 2 or 3 of this period. You take four 800 mcg pills of misoprostol during this time. The pregnancy is forced out of your uterus as a result of this tablet.
- Follow-up from days 7 to 14 a follow-up appointment is required to ensure that you are not pregnant the mifepristone and misoprostol abortion pill combination for pregnancies that are less than 70 days (10 weeks) from your last period.
- Women should be permitted to self-manage their abortions at home using abortion pills for up to 12 weeks, from beginning to end.



## **Doses of medicine**

- Take mifepristone by mouth as directed by your expert, usually as a single dose. After taking mifepristone, your professional should direct you to wait 24 to 48 hours before taking another tablet (misoprostol) by mouth as a single dose.
- The pill may not work as well if you take misoprostol sooner than 24 hours after taking mifepristone or later than 48 hours after taking mifepristone. Follow your healthcare expert instructions carefully.



**Storage** 

- Store the medicine in a closed container at room temperature, away from heat, moisture, and direct light. Keep from freezing.
- Keep out of the reach of children.
- Do not keep outdated medicine or medicine no longer needed.
- Ask your healthcare professional how you should dispose of any medicine you do not use.



### Benefits of the MTP kit

Undergoing an abortion is a personal choice. MTP kit helps treat unwanted pregnancy and also involves benefits as follows:

- It can be used in the early weeks of pregnancy (less than nine weeks)
- No need for anaesthesia and surgery
- More privacy
