- Eileen Feng Gu (born September 3, 2003), also known by her Chinese name Gu Ailing is an American-born freestyle skier. She has competed in halfpipe, slopestyle and big air events for China since 2019. There has always been a dispute with Gu regarding her
- nationality. She's running for China (a country that doesn't allow dual citizenship), but she shows no signs of giving up her American citizenship. In an interview after the 2022 Winter Olympics, Gu was asked about her nationality, but did not answer directly, saying that both the American and Chinese teams were part of her work because of her goal of bringing people together through sport. She has always been vague about her nationality, and given her large commercial value and annual profits in China (currently estimated at RMB 130 million), she believes American citizenship. Both of **Eileen Gu parents** are retired. Her father worked in a factory and her mother was a stay-at-home mom. Irene Gu's parents are from China.
